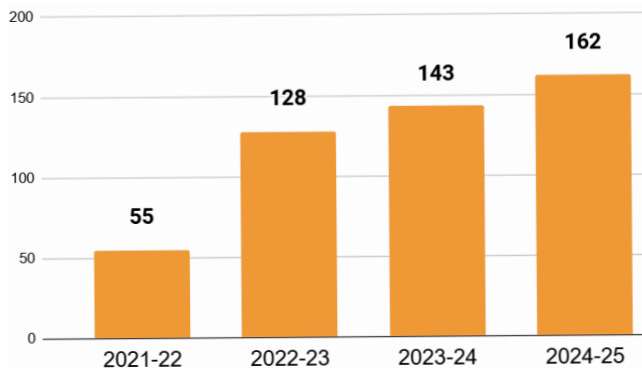
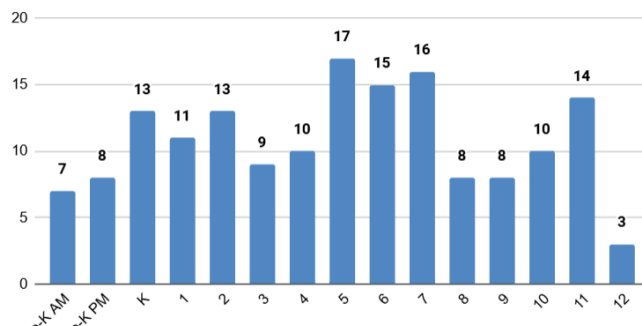


OUR SERVICE STATISTICS

CUSTER COUNTY BACKPACK PROJECT



Serving Westcliffe CO Public School Students



The Custer County Backpack Project (CCBP) is a **nonprofit** community service that provides backpacks filled with required grade-level school supplies free of charge to requesting parents.

CCBP began in 2016 as a service of the local **Valley Park, Recreation, and Youth Center (VPR&YC)**, a 501(c)(3) organization. For the past five years, the Custer County Church of Christ has provided oversight under the umbrella of VPR&YC .

CCBP provided **162 backpacks full of school supplies** in 2024-2025, both to students starting in August and to those who moved in during the school year. It also provides art sketchbooks, specialty paper, and specific requests to teachers. Our annual budget averages **\$5000**.

No other program helps the district so extensively with providing school materials. It is funded entirely by **grants and donations** from events, individuals, churches, organizations, and businesses.
